The ARARFURA Games have been held in Darwin every 2 years since 1991. They attract over 3000 athletes from 25 nations, participating in 29 sports. This year they are May17-24TH.

Basketball NT have received early nominations from Malaysia, Philipines, Macau, Aust Defence Force and New Guinea. They have also had interest from New Zealand and Americian College Teams. 2003 will be the first year of Wheelchair Basketball.

Basketball NT requires the help of Scoretable Officials. If you apply as an official and receive an accreditation pass you will be entitled to use the bed-bank (cheap accommodation offered by Darwin Hotels). Basketball NT is not in the position to offer financial assistance, but will help find accommodation.

FROM EVALUATIONS

All Scoretable Officials will be at the Scoretable at a minimum of 30 minutes prior to the advertised game time

If you are not at the table or you cannot convince the Scoretable Coach that you were unavoidably detained then the evaluation you receive will not be recorded. Don't have other jobs other than your Scoretable one.

Read the Code of Conduct. If the Association cannot get a sufficient number of people to run the game without you, should they be in the competition?.

The VBL Tournament is on again this year, March 8, 9, & 10. At Frankston. There will be evaluations done on a lot of games. If you are interested ring Carol Flint use the email address.
