EDUCATION

- A noticeable item since the commencement of the Season has been the lack of help offered by some of our Level 3's and Level 4's to other officials.
Please help out where you can and share your knowledge to help others to attain the competencies that you have.

It has become apparent with the system we have in place that some common errors are turning up.

Chairperson

1. Do not point direction of arrow.
2. Do not signal back types of fouls – there have been a few chairpersons signaling back Technical fouls.

Scorer (Handbook pgs 45, 50 & 52 - Rule Book pgs 104, 108 & 110)

1. On the sheet where there is no name listed rule through from left to right into the last foul.
2. Circle score every quarter
Extra Period (if not used) Time Outs are recorded with =
Extra Period (if not used) Box scores record nothing.

Assistant Scorer

1. Points good and shooting foul with 1 bonus to come. Nothing is recorded on the board until the referee comes to the Scoretable.
2. Light and Dark on the board – If the teams are not specifically named on the board then light and dark is worked on the solid colour of the uniform. The uniform which is predominately light is Light and the dark uniform is Dark (It has nothing to do with numbers)

Timekeeper (Handbook Page 36)

You must use a **hand held timing device** (Not a wrist watch) to time the:

1. Time outs
2. Fouled out or disqualified player
3. Injured Player.

24 Second Operator (Rule book page 35 article 11.2)

1. **Stopped and reset** to 24 as soon as a shot for a **field goal enters the basket**
2. **Stopped and reset** to 24 as soon as a **shot for a field goal touches the ring.**
3. Resets on fouls occur when the referee comes clear of the players.

A note for Convenors

When a coach arrives to evaluate and you are running a four man scoretable then you will be asked by the Coach to change to a FIBA scoretable with no Chairperson. In this case we will evaluate a scorer, assistant scorer, timekeeper and shot clock.

If we arrive and you are running with 3 officials

there will be no evaluation carried out. 😊
