### **Uniform Sale**


Stocks of existing uniforms will be available at **half price**—this special deal will provide the opportunity for scorers to purchase a uniform at very reasonable cost.

### From Basketball Victoria ...

Basketball Victoria is concerned at the increasing number of complaints being made about the use of Facebook, Twitter, U-Tube and other social networking sites by people involved in basketball, for unacceptable content.

We have seen examples where the sites have been used to bully other basketballers, to criticise referees and to make racist or sexist remarks about other participants. *This sort of behaviour is to-tally unacceptable in basketball and will not be tolerated*.

Many of the remarks are being made with the posters believing that because those remarks can only be seen by people they have accepted as friends on their pages, they will not be made public. However, fortunately, there are enough decent people around who bring this behaviour to the attention of Basketball Clubs or Associations or Basketball Victoria. This occurs even when the posts are made by friends because those people recognise the harm and distress this sort of behaviour can generate.

Under Basketball Victoria's Tribunal By-laws and Member Protection By-laws, behaviour which is unacceptable can be brought to the Tribunal, even if it didn't occur on the basketball court. As long as the incident is basketball related, the Tribunal can deal with it. A number of Facebook issues have already been dealt with by the Tribunal and other hearings are pending.

Basketball Victoria will have no hesitation in reporting to the Tribunal incidents who misuse such sites if it relates to basketball. Please be mindful of other basketball participants and don't place yourself at risk of finding yourself reported to the Tribunal, as has happened to several people already.

#### Use of non scoretable uniform

All members please note that our parent body, VBRA, have directed that the practice of wearing alternate uniforms on the scoretable is to cease.

The following has been extracted from the minutes of the VBRA board meeting dated  $20^{\rm th}$  August 2009.

"If branches wish to use different uniforms on the Scoretable they need permission to avoid conflict with sponsors etc.

VBRA direction [is] to stop the practice ASAP or seek appropriate approval. Scoretable to implement new logo and ensure uniform procedure is adhered to"

All Convenors were required to comply with the above, effective 1<sup>st</sup> January 2010.

## Australian U16 Championships ...

In July, the Australian U16 Championships were held in Logan, Queensland. Vicky Lowe represented the VBSA and reports on her experience...

It was my pleasure to be chosen as the Victorian Representative of the Score-table Association for the Under 16 Championships held in Logan Queensland. It was a fantastic experience and great to meet representatives from the other states. We discussed various procedures, mentored other scorers and to the referees we became the friendly face on the bench.

We stayed at the same motel as the referees. The owners of the motel could not have been more accommodating. The difficulty we did have was transport, as we had to rely on the referee bus or alternative. At times this meant long stints at the stadium. This was further compounded with the stadium not being in walking distance of other facilities. This could be alleviated by hiring a car or making a car available We did learn that trying to hire a car during the school holidays is not viable. However it was excellent staying with the referees, and they even commented on enjoying our presence. The Queensland folk were very obliging and helpful to make our stay enjoyable.

I do believe it is necessary to raise the profile of the score-table. It would even be nice if a thank you could be given at the end. Wendy O'Brien had everything under control. It was interesting in that evaluators were present and many scorers were being assessed at the various levels. This could in fact be an incentive for scorers to take part.

All games did not have outside access. This meant there was no continuous stream of people parading past the score-bench. Coaches and referees did not have the scream of others around them. Belongings of volunteers, players, referees, score-table and statistics staff were actually quite safe and didn't have to be monitored as there was no outside influence. It did make the playing area a very efficient work space.

For those loving their holidays, don't expect to go and have a restful time. This type of event is full on and you will certainly return exhausted. However I would have no hesitation in going again and believe it is necessary to develop camaraderie with the other states .
