The first week of October saw us trek to Dandenong Basketball Stadium for the U14 Club Championships.


For the first time, both girls & boys competitions were held under the one roof making a total of 184 games over 6 days. Despite a variety of

Quiz

- A. After an out-of-bounds violation, the player standing on the side lines leans in and places the ball on the playing court. He then enters the court and picks the ball up. Is this allowed?
- B. The Coach of the Red team requests a Time-out stating "only if the Blue team scores". Is this a correct request?
- C. With 10 seconds remaining on the shot clock A1 releases a shot for a field goal. While the ball is in the air B2 commits a foul on A2. It is team B's 2nd foul in the period. The ball:
- a Enters the basket
 - b Hits the ring but does not enter the basket
- What should be on the shot clock for both?

Answers from last edition

- A. An unsportsmanlike foul is called on player Red 6 followed by a technical foul does this disqualify the player.
- Answer: Yes. Game disqualification (Art 36.3.3 and Art 37.2.3). The October 2018 FIBA Rules now adds Game disqualification for 1 technical and 1 unsportsmanlike foul.**
- B. With 23 seconds on the game clock team A gains new control of the ball. With 19 seconds on the game clock A1 shoots for a field goal. The ball touches the ring and A2 gets the rebound. What should be on the Shot clock.
- Answer: The shot clock is to be set at 14 as soon as A2 gains control of the ball. (Interpretations 29/50-51)**
- C. A1 shoots for a field goal. The ball touches the ring. A2 taps the ball and then A3 gains control of the ball. Shot clock?
- Answer: The shot clock shall be reset to 14 seconds as soon as A3 gains control of the ball anywhere on the playing court. (Interpretations 29/50-39)**

Disqualifying Fouls

Technical

The **second** technical foul by a player is recorded as a **T** with any corresponding free-throws awarded (the same way as you record the first Tech).

Then write **GD** (game disqualification) in the next box on the sheet and draw a horizontal line through any unused foul boxes.

See B.8.3.2

Unsportsmanlike

The **second** unsportsmanlike foul by a player is recorded as a **U** with any corresponding free-throws awarded (the same way as you record the first one).

Then write **GD** (game disqualification) in the next box on the sheet and draw a horizontal line through any unused foul boxes

See B.8.3.5

Disqualification

A player is disqualified if they receive two technical fouls OR two unsportsmanlike fouls OR one technical foul and one unsportsmanlike foul.

GD is entered in the next box on the sheet following the foul awarded—**T** or **U**—then draw a horizontal line through any unused foul boxes.
