## A fond farewell to Daryl and Christine (Chris) Lynch



### Basketball History – Daryl and Chris Lynch

Daryl started scoring at Nunawading in 1995, Chris in 1999.

Daryl did his level 2 exam in 1996, Chris in 2000.

Daryl did level 3 in 1999, Chris in 2003

Daryl did level 4 in 2012 at FIBA Oceania tournament

Both commenced at Nunawading, but after being asked to assist at Blackburn frequently in 2000, transferred memberships to Blackburn in 2001 and involved family members and their friends as well as Blackburn locals.

They have assisted various clubs when needed, individually, as a couple and as a family. These clubs included Waverley, Ringwood, Kilsyth, Dandenong, Maccabi, Monash University, Melbourne University, Melbourne Tigers, Bulleen Boomers, Latrobe University, Mackinnon and Coburg.

Helping out Bulleen Boomers Big V led to some games with Bulleen Boomers WNBL which ultimately led to an opportunity with Melbourne Tigers Big V teams, and then the Melbourne Tigers NBL team and Melbourne United for many years.

Daryl became a scoretable coach in 2009 and educator in 2010 conducting many level 1 and level 2 schools over several years. Chris became a scoretable coach in 2016.

While at Blackburn, Daryl, assisted by Chris and then Grant, was the Big V Delegate and Game Day Coordinator for several years.

“It gave us an extraordinary amount of pleasure to mentor young scorers and see their progression over their scoring journey, and try to provide opportunities to progress to the highest levels.” \*\*

In 2018 we retired from active scoring, being awarded life membership of Blackburn Basketball Association, and transferred our memberships to Central Melbourne. We are retiring from all forms of basketball service at the end of the 2019 season. Other pursuits have called us to travel more.

## Quiz answers

1. How is a fighting foul by a team delegation member (eg: Physiotherapist) who leaves the bench and engages in a fight, recorded on the score sheet?

**Answer:** A disqualifying foul against an accompanying delegation member for his active involvement in the fight shall be charged against the coach and recorded as follows:

Coach	788	LOOR, A.	B2
Assistant Coach	555	MONTANA, B.	

Each disqualification of an accompanying delegation member shall be charged against the coach, recorded as B2, but shall not count to the three technical fouls for his disqualification.

**Article: B.8.3.14**

2. A player from the Blue team, deliberately makes a basket for the opposition? Does this count? If so, against whose name are the points recorded? If not, who gets possession of the ball after the basket?

**Answer:** No it does not count. It is a violation.

**Article 16.2.3**

3. How does a team make a protest against the outcome of the game?

**Answer:** Protest Procedures
